We started with a rugged motocross-type double loop cradle frame, and heavy duty suspension. The rear suspension has progressively wound springs, with five settings. The long travel front forks have oil dampened shock absorbers.

The gutty 97cc engine boasts Reed Valve Torque Induction for plenty of low end

that are almost impossible to break off, Autolube (to auto-

matically and economically mix your gas and oil), and a surprisingly low price.
