Other distinctive features of this trail conqueror include Yamaha's exclusive Autolube oil injection system; higher ground clearance, with skid plate; primary kick starting in any gear; big, comfortable saddle; completely new, 5-step adjustable rear shocks; separate speedometer and tach; bigger brakes (waterproof and dust-proof of course); and *much bigger and brighter* head, tail and stop lights. One of the *better machines* from Yamaha for the man who wants excitement, comfort, economy and enjoyment in one dependable bike.



An amazing revolution in engine design, the Yamaha 5-port engine has two extra ports at the back of the cylinder to exhaust burnt gases and thus permit fresh fuel to completely fill the chamber instead of wasted out the exhaust. Using no more gas, power is, therefore, increased an astonishing 10%. In addition, this model features Yamaha's exclusive Autolube oil injection system for longer engine wear and extra economy.

"Superlative" is the way this 5-speed gearbox is often described. You'll agree. Shifting is the smoothest ever. Just a touch of the toe and you're right in the gear you want. Constant-mesh synchronization is perfect. No break-in time either. No grinding. No clashing. No missed shifts. Moving up or down, each of the 5 gears from lowest to highest brings the ultimate in quick and easy shifts, with complete flexibility.

Just as on every Enduro model, the brakes are large, fade-free, dust-proof and waterproof for safe biking in any weather. Special universal-type knobby tires are ideal for riding off the road, giving complete traction in even the muddiest terrain. And, for extra versatility, the 5-step rear suspension is completely adjustable to meet a variety of riding conditions.

Yamaha's renowned Enduro front forks are engineered to absorb a lot more punishment than you'll probably ever give them. And bring a new dimension in riding comfort on even the roughest trail. No external springs and no rubber boots. Amazing performance and comfort wherever you go.

The new CT1-C has many more features too. Like the Scrambler-type bridge crossbar. The separate speedometer and tach. Plus new and much bigger and brighter head, tail and stop lights. And, this year, front and rear flasher signals and ball-joint rear view mirror are standard. Higher ground clearance, easy-to-reach switches conveniently located. Every feature to make this model distinctive.
