

The 1977 YZ 100... Its the short

For beginning motocrossers, the YZ 100 is a good start. It's lightweight, it handles well, and best of all, it's built to win.

The polypropylene fenders and double-loop tubular steel frame are lightweight, yet durable. The frame and engine mounting create a low center of gravity for better steering characteristics. And the center-mount exhaust system creates a narrower profile for more control. It is routed out of the way under the padded

saddle for greater ground clearance.

The YZ 100 handles better because it is light-weight. The long-travel, heavy duty front forks and De Carbon Monocross Suspension provide comfort and stability.

The YZ 100 has a gutsy two-stroke single cylinder engine. The six-speed transmission helps keep the engine within the powerband. And Torque Induction delivers more pulling power,

especially in the mid range, where you need it.

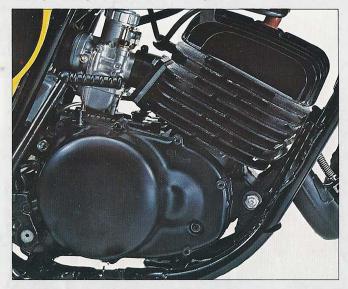

Torque Induction, a unique feature of Yamaha twostroke single engines, utilizes reed valves system to prevent carburetor blowback. The result is more horsepower, particularly at low rpms.





De Carbon Monocross Suspension, Yamaha's revolutionary suspension system, provides greater rear wheel travel for better control, more comfort and consistent traction over rough terrain.

Capacitor Discharge Ignition System produces a hotter, more efficient spark at all engine speeds and helps reduce spark plug fouling.





Heavy-duty front forks are air-cushioned, with long travel for soaking up bumps. Alloy rims and conical front hubs reduce weight and the lightweight polypropylene fenders are virtually unbreakable.

Close-ratio six-speed transmission allows the engine to run at its most efficient speed. The improved shifter allows quick, positive gear changes.





Center-mount exhaust system is routed out of the way, under the padded saddle, for more protection from road obstacles. A tuned silencer reduces noise without affecting performance.



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
