Details of changes

- The procedure for handlebar disassembly has been changed and as a result, the place where the disassembled parts are carried has been partly changed.
- Due to change in the sequence of disassembly, the following parts, which used to be held to the frame, are now contained in a vinyl bag:
 - *Bolts and plate washers for front fender installation.












SET-UP PROCEDURES

This model is designed upon the GT80E but built as an off-road machine like the YZ series machine, so the headlight, speedometer, flasher lights, tail light, and battery are removed. When assembling this model, refer to the GT80E Assembly Manual (90894-07803/-LIT-11666-01-06).

Handlebar installation has been changed as follows:

 Install the speedometer and lower handle holder to handle crown using spring washer, plate washer and hexagon nut (M6).



Tightening torque: 3.0 m-kg (22 ft-lb)

Grease the right end of the handlebar and the throttle grip housing and temporarily fit the throttle grip.




3. Install the handlebar using two upper holders, four hexagon bolts with washer.

Tightening torque: 1.0 m-kg (7 ft-lb)

CAUTION:-

Tighten bolts in stages and maintain an equal gap on each side of both holders.



1. Holder 2. Handlebar


 Slip the throttle grip over the handlebar to the limit and slide it back about 5 mm (0.2 in). Assemble the throttle housing using the screws provided.





WARNING:-


Make certain throttle grip rotates on the handlebar freely without binding. If not, normal throttle return will be impaired.

CABLE ROUTING










WIRING DIAGRAM
