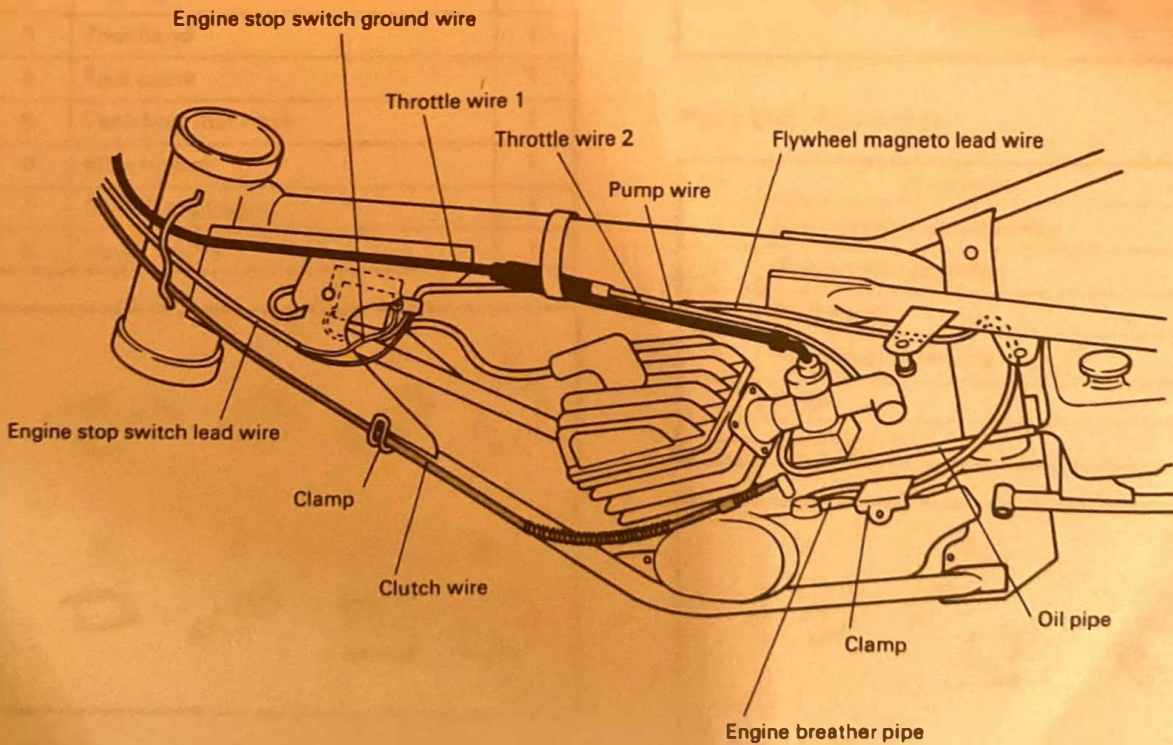
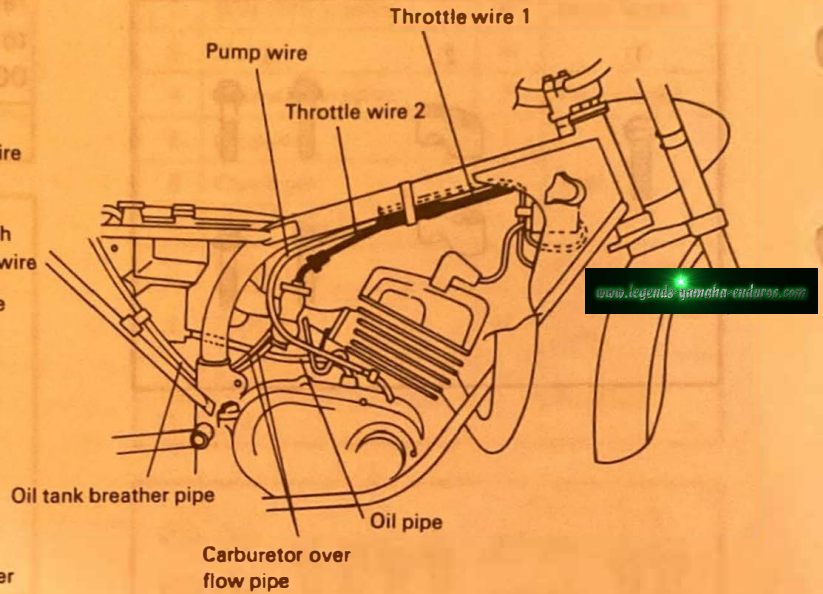
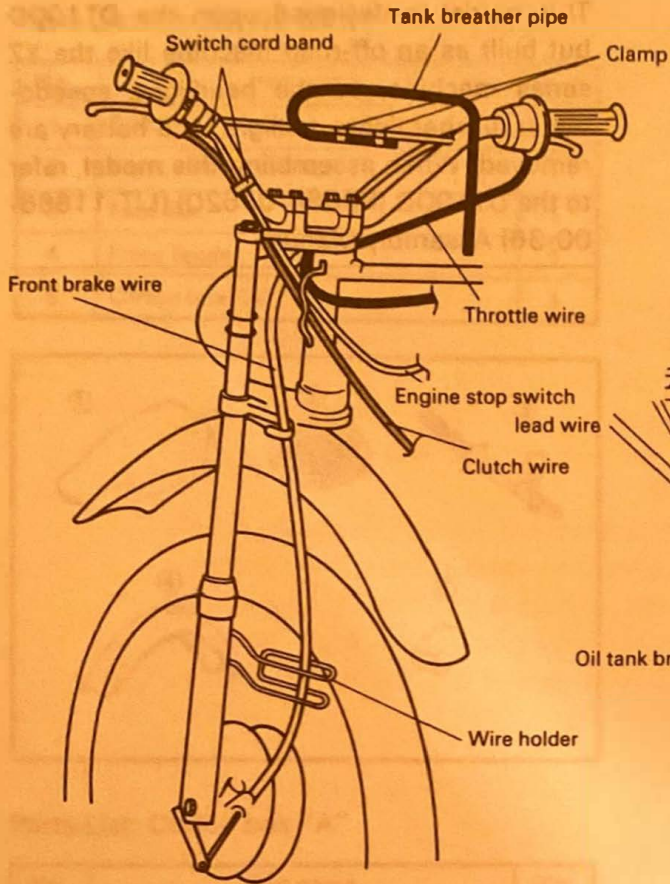


SET-UP PROCEDURES

NOTE:

This model is designed upon the DT100D but built as an off-road machine like the YZ series machine, so the headlight, speedometer, flasher lights, taillight, and battery are removed. When assembling this model, refer to the DT100D (90894-07620) (LIT-11666-00-36) Assembly Manual.

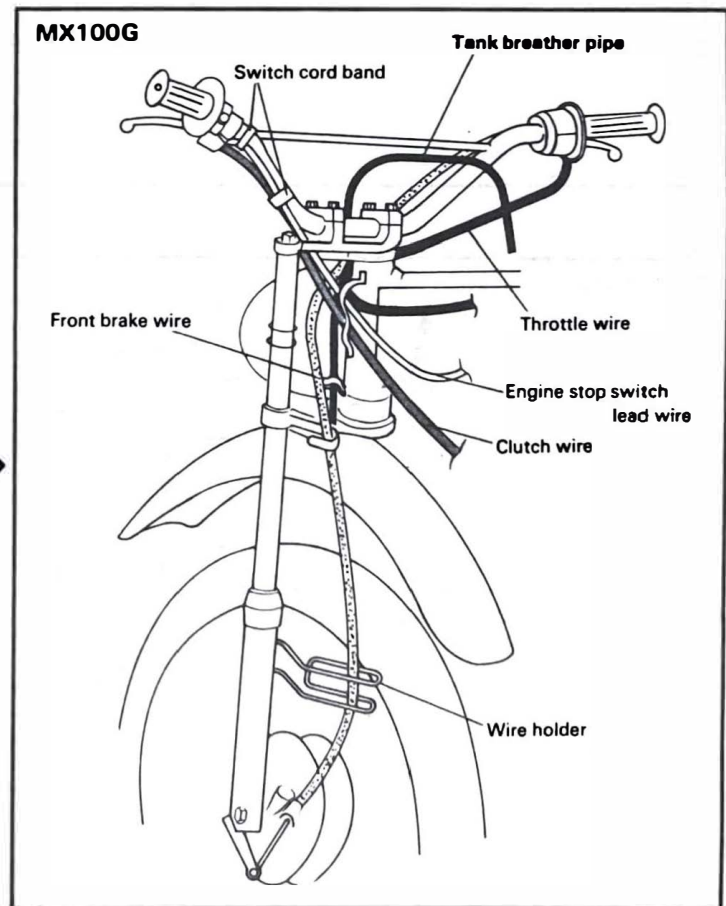
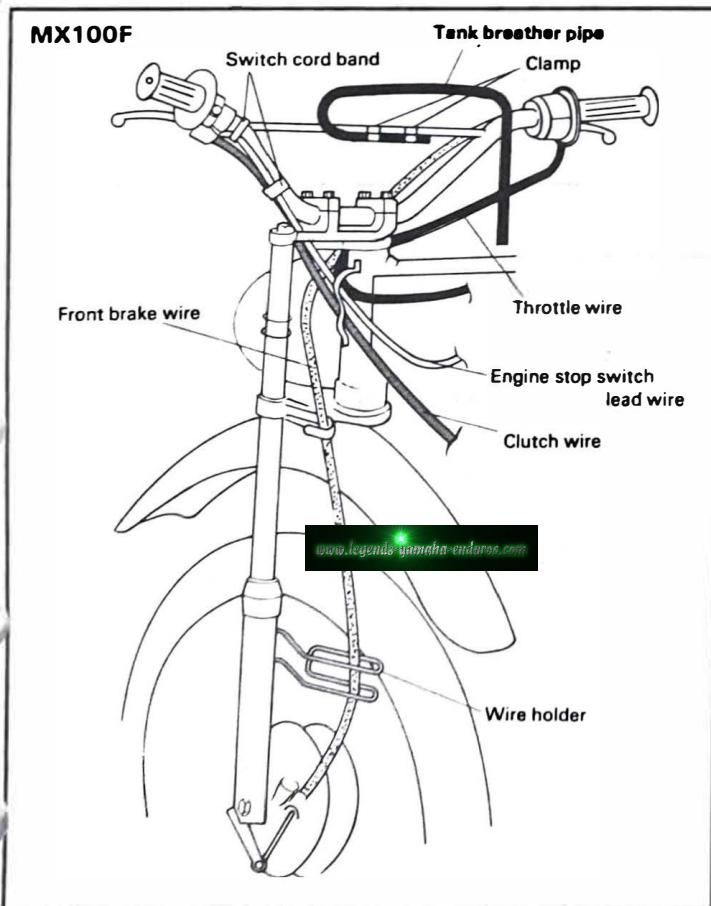
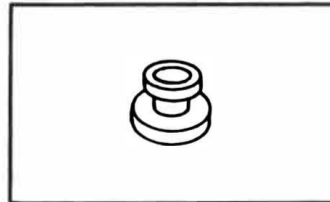
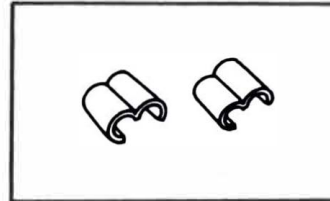
CABLE ROUTING DIAGRAM



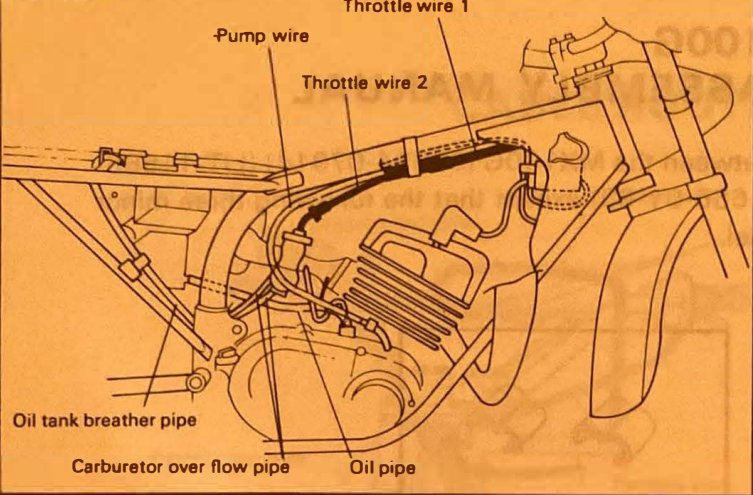
MX100G SUPPLEMENTARY ASSEMBLY MANUAL

There is no particular difference in assembly between the MX100G (90894-07914) (LIT-11666-01-70) and MX100F (90894-07841) (LIT-11666-01-63) except that the following three minor points are changed as opposed to the "F" model.

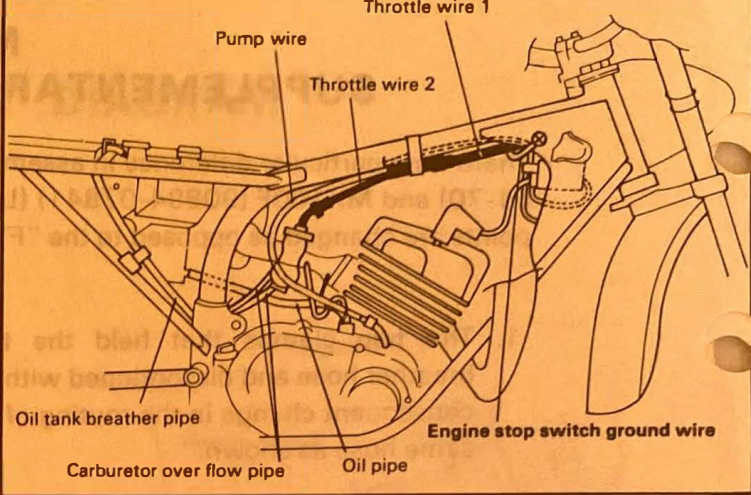
1. The two clamps that held the tank breather hose and discontinued with the consequent change in the routing of the same hose as shown.
2. The front wheel collar that used to be placed bare on the foam tray is now placed in a vinyl bag on the same base
3. Following the discontinuation of the tank breather pipe clamps as mentioned above and the adoption of the CDI magneto, the cable routing diagram is changed.



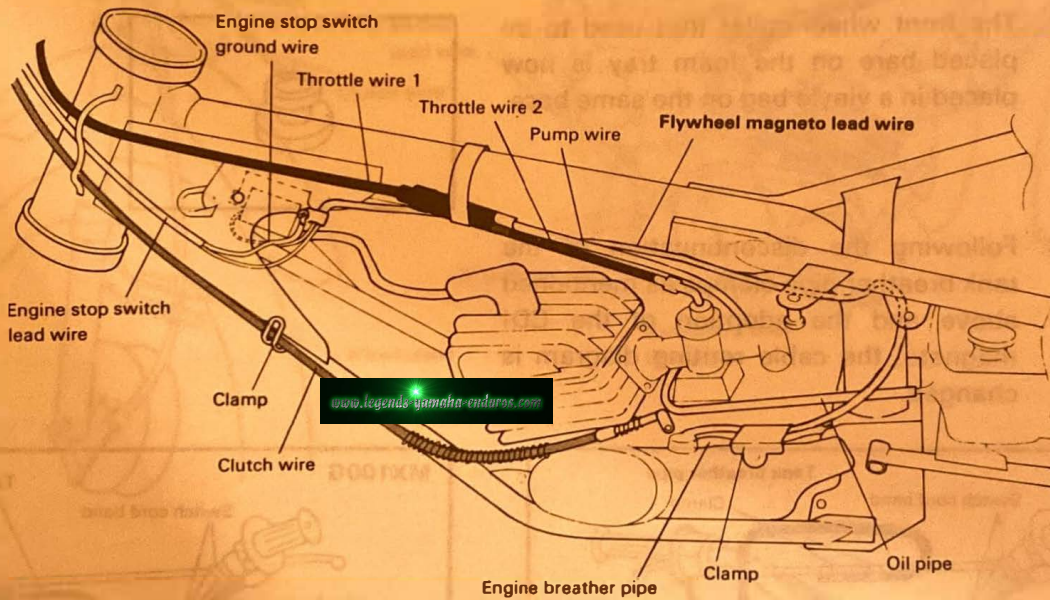

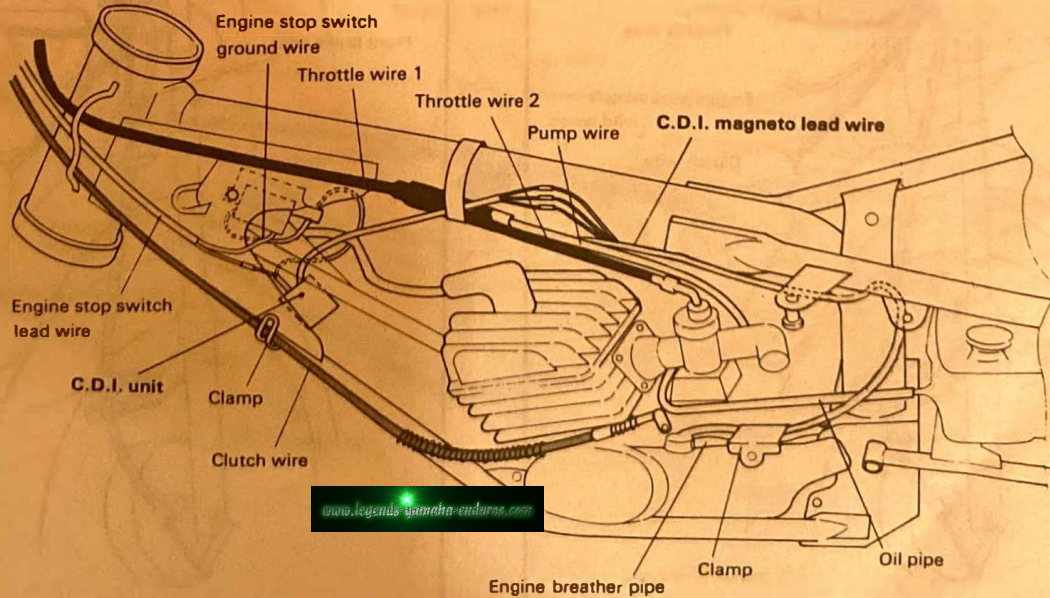
