YAMAHA MOTORCYCLE WARRANTY

As set forth herein, the term "machine" shall refer to motorcycle as manufactured by Yamaha and sold by an authorized Yamaha dealer within the United States. "Company" shall refer to Yamaha International Corporation acting through its duly authorized and franchised motorcycle dealers.

- (A) Period of warranty shall be 6 months from date of delivery or 4000 miles, whichever occurs first; 90 days for the Mini Enduro. During the period of warranty, Company guarantees to the original purchaser of each new Yamaha:
 - Any part adjudged defective by reason of faulty workmanship or material from the factory shall be performed free of charge.
 - 2. Any repairs and/or adjustments made necessary by faulty workmanship or material from the factory shall be replaced free of charge.
- (B) This warranty shall be effective is purchaser:
 - Submits machine to an authorized dealer for the required service checks (500, 1000, 2000, 3000 miles) as noted in the Owner's Warranty Guide Book, and
 - 2. Gives notice to an authorized Yamaha dealer of any and all apparent defects within ten (10) days after discovery and immediately makes the machine available for inspection and repairs at such dealer's place of business.
- (C) Warranty repairs should be performed by the selling dealer, unless the purchaser has moved more than fifty miles from the selling dealer or is touring more than fifty miles from the selling dealer.

(D) Warranty shall not extend to:

 Machines subjected to abnormal strain or abuse.

2. Machines which have not been main-

tained properly or neglected.

- Machines altered from standard condition.
- 4. Failures of, or failures caused by parts or accessories not manufactured by Yamaha.
- 5. Machines used in competition of any kind.
- 6. Machines designed specifically for competition, (MX, Road Racers, etc.)

7. Accident or collision damage.

8. Parts replaced due to normal wear, or routine maintenance. (Ignition components, spark plugs, etc.)

Machines which have had the speedometer (odometer) removed or altered.

Machine's used for renting, leasing, or other commercial purposes.

- 1. COMPANY'S LIABILITY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THAT SET FORTH IN THIS WARRANTY, AND COMPANY SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING INJURY TO PERSON OR PROPERTY.
- 2. COMPANY MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED; AND ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE WHICH EXCEED THE OBLIGATION STATED IN THIS WARRANTY ARE HEREBY DISCLAIMED BY COMPANY AND EXCLUDED FROM THIS WARRANTY.
