The simple, maintenance-free YEIS smoothes out power delivery and improves mid-range engine performance — characteristics vital for an enduro machine. The chassis has also been improved to give more precise, positive handling. The rear suspension incorporates the latest developments in Yamaha's suspension engineering. 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link the box-section swing arm and the De Carbon type gas/oil strut. This new Monocross system provides rising-rate cushioning while extending the wheel movement to 270mm. Front suspension has also been refined with larger-diameter fork inner tubes and special reduced friction bushes. As you would expect on a competition-bred machine, the forks are air-assisted and the wheels are fitted with lightweight conical hubs.

It is perhaps in the detailed refinements that the IT175 most clearly reveals its competition heritage. Details like quick-release wheels, gear-activated throttle, rim

saver tyres and lightweight sump guard, to name a few. Finally, like all Yamahas, the

T175 is dramatically styled for looks that live up to its performance.

A comprehensive tool kit is supplied with the machine.

New rising-rate Monocross suspension uses box-section swing arm and De Carbon type gas/oil strut which has adjustability for damping and spring preload. Extended 270mm wheel travel and progressive action improve the IT175's potential.

Yamaha Energy Induction System provides a useful boost to mid-range power output.
